Global Gateway Connector Pedestrian Bridge Funding Agreement

The Office of the City Manager is pleased to report that the City of College Park was able to finally secure a fully executed project funding agreement with the Georgia Department of Transportation earlier this week to fund professional engineering design services for the future construction of the Global Gateway Connector Pedestrian Bridge. As previously reported, our community now enjoys a nearly \$700,000 commitment for this purpose, necessary to ultimately secure capital improvement funding for actual construction activity. Direction is therefore now being offered to recommend applicable transactions involving both Prime Engineering, as well as related subcontractor services from Metropolitan Atlanta based Pentagon Engineering. Considerations for review and dialogue respectively are likewise being planned for the August 1st regular meeting.

Greenspring Road Stormwater Control Structure Considerations

As the Greenspring Road Stormwater Control Structure series of projects are presently a commitment of the City of College Park via a Georgia Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS 4) permit that was first issued circa 1999, both the Department of Engineering and the Department of Public Works have been recently asked to work collaboratively to offer recommendations as to how city administration should proceed. referenced in the attached electronic mail message from Director of Engineering William Moore, considerations to this effect include various repair and construction activities, to also summarize resulting maintenance responsibilities. Initially, all involved contemplated hiring a design firm to offer proposed solutions and alternatives. However, given associated cost inefficiencies with this approach, some work to this effect has been determined to be achievable via internal capabilities. Updates and opportunities to formally offer direction accordingly will therefore be offered publicly during an upcoming workshop meeting.

Efforts to Continuously Resolve Unsightly Utility Line Conditions

Given recent efforts by College Park Power to collaborate with both AT&T and other communications related service providers to address unsightly utility infrastructure conditions in our community, all involved are pleased to report that progress continues respectively. As referenced in the attached electronic mail message from AT&T Regional Director of External Affairs Dennis Boyden, responsiveness to this effect was offered during the past few weeks along Princeton Avenue; the Janice Road/Yates Road vicinity; Sullivan Road; Old National Highway; and Jackson Street. Although other outstanding issues as noted remain in various sections of College Park, the cooperation presently enjoyed represents a noticeable improvement accordingly. Both the Office of the City Manager and College Park Power are therefore very much encouraged to continue practices and protocols to help ensure continued momentum as outlined.

Final Arrangements to Rename Arlene Drive to Jesse A. Dent, Jr. Drive

I am pleased to report that city administration has successfully concluded necessary tasks to rename Arlene Drive to Jesse A. Dent, Jr. Drive. As referenced in the attached memorandum/formal notification from Director of Engineering William Moore, this includes applicable notification to all involved federal, state, and local jurisdictions, including leadership of the United State Postal Service. Additionally, a total of 18 property owners and

four tenants have been advised, enabling the permanent updating of their mail distribution records effective July 1, 2016. Pastor Marjorie Dent is therefore planning to host a street sign uncovering ceremony for Saturday, July 2nd at 1:00 pm, at the intersection of Karen Road and Jesse A. Dent, Jr. Drive. A crew for the Department of Public Works will likewise assist with related logistics, including timely new sign installation and unveiling activities during this event.

Calendar of Meetings, Activities, and Functions

Director of Airport Affairs Gary Young and I met with both Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International (HJAIA) Airport Interim General Manager Roosevelt Council and key members of his leadership team yesterday morning to discuss various matters of mutual concerns, as well as to highlight various opportunities to move forward respectively. This dialogue included agenda items for the pending July 20th quarterly meeting between City of College Park staff and the City of Atlanta Department of Aviation, and offers of congratulations and support for Mr. Council's new role. We adjourned the meeting with a sense that minimal disruption will exist due to changes in administrative leadership at HJAIA, helping to alleviate concerns accordingly. Likewise, all involved should be able to continue to maintain general progress as a result.
